



Order to be entered in Cause CD No. 200805747-T for the Senora, Calvin, Thurman, Red Fork, Bartlesville, Savanna, Booch, Hartshorne, Gilcrease, Wapanucka, Union Valley, Cromwell, Jefferson, Mississippian, Woodford, Misener, Hunton, Viola, Simpson Dolomite, Wilcox and Arbuckle common sources of supply underlying Section 9, Township 10 North, Range 9 East, Okfuskee County, Oklahoma. The interests of the oil and gas owners involved herein and the rights and equities in respect thereto are sought herein to be pooled and adjudicated pursuant to 52 O.S. Sec. 87.1 within and on the basis of the drilling and spacing units covered hereby, and not limited to a single wellbore. The application in this cause states that Applicant has proposed the development of the separate common source of supply in the drilling and spacing units involved herein under a plan development and has proposed to commence such plan of development of such units by an initial unit well in the lands covered hereby, and that Applicant has been unable to reach an agreement with the owners of drilling rights named as respondents herein with respect to such proposed plan of development of the separate common source of supply in the drilling and spacing units covered hereby.
