NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Applicant requests that the Corporation Commission of Oklahoma enter an order, to be effective as of the date of the execution thereof or as of a date prior thereto, as follows:

(A) Approving a multiunit horizontal well in the 640-acre drilling and spacing units formed for the Target Mississippian, the Adjacent Woodford and Hutton common sources of supply in Sections 4 and 9, Township 18 North, Range 14 West, Dewey County, Oklahoma, to allow such multiunit horizontal well to be drilled as described above, and to be completed in and to produce hydrocarbons from the above-named separate common sources of supply, and establishing of a proper allocation factor for allocating the cost of and the production and proceeds from such multiunit horizontal well to each of the affected units covered hereby; and

(B) Granting such other and further relief as may be proper based upon the evidence presented at the hearing herein.

The legal descriptions of the land sections adjacent to the area within which the location lies are Sections 3, 5, 8, 10, 15, 16 and 17, Township 18 North, Range 14 West and Sections 32, 33 and 34, Township 19 North, Range 14 West, Dewey County, Oklahoma. Applicant further requests that Applicant or some other party be authorized the right to drill said well.

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Applicant further requests that it be permitted to produce said well at said location from all common sources of supply covered hereby, without any downward allowable adjustment.
