As objection(s) to the Application have been filed, Oklahoma Corporation Commission rules, specifically Oklahoma Administrative Code ("OAC") 165:10-5-5 and 165:5-7-27, require that the Application be set for hearing and notice thereof be given in the same manner as required for the filing of the Application on the Commission's Pollution Docket.

We request that you file the OCC Form 1015 Application and the Notice of Hearing with the Court Clerk's Office within thirty (30) days of the date of this letter. The Notice of Hearing must be published in newspapers of general circulation in both Oklahoma County, Oklahoma, and the county where the proposed well is to be located. The Notice of Hearing must be published at least fifteen (15) days prior to the hearing date, and proofs of publication of such Notice of Hearing need to be filed with the Court Clerk's Office.

You need to refer to the Commission's Oil and Gas Conservation Rules (OAC 165: Chapter 10) and Rules of Practice (OAC 165: Chapter 5) regarding additional requirements. You may need to have an attorney represent you in this matter. An individual may appear on his own behalf.
