**FINAL CITATION ORDER – DISMISSING CAUSE**

COMES NOW the Applicant in the above-styled and numbered Cause, by and through her attorney, and prior to the commencement of the hearing on the Complaint and recommends that the captioned Cause be dismissed without prejudice pursuant to OAC 165:5-9-2(e).

Commission Field Inspector, Roger Pearman, alleges that the Respondent is the owner/operator of the subject well and that the Geo #3: S/2 NE/4 SE/4 NW/4, Section 24, Township 14 North, Range 07 East, Creek County, Oklahoma was being used as an injection/disposal well without a permit as required by OCC-OAC 165:10-5-2. The Rule provides that “The Commission shall fine an operator \$5,000.00 for any violation of this subsection.

To resolve the matter, Respondent permitted the well and agreed to pay the \$5,000.00 fine.

IT IS THEREFORE THE ORDER of the Commission that this Cause is dismissed.


