THE COMMISSION FURTHER FINDS that the Motion complies with the requirements of OAC 165:5-9-2 and 5-13-3(p).


ORDER

THE COMMISSION THEREFORE ORDERS that the Motion to Reopen filed by PUD be granted and the same is hereby ordered in accordance with the findings herein.


THE COMMISSION FURTHER ORDERS that the Findings of Fact and Conclusions of Law set forth herein are hereby adopted as the Order of the Commission.

THIS ORDER SHALL BE EFFECTIVE immediately.




