PUBLIC UTILITY DIVISION’S RESPONSE REGARDING APPLICANT’S COMPLIANCE WITH THE MINIMUM FILING REQUIREMENTS

COMES NOW Brandy L. Wreath, Director of the Public Utility Division (“PUD”) of the Oklahoma Corporation Commission (“Commission”), by and through the undersigned counsel, and pursuant to OAC 165:70-3-1(c) shows as follows:

1. On March 16, 2021, Public Service Company of Oklahoma (“PSO”) filed in this Cause its Notice of Intent, giving notice to the Commission of PSO’s intent to file an Application seeking to modify its rates and charges for PSO’s Oklahoma jurisdictional customers as well as to amend PSO’s Electric Service Rules, Regulations and Conditions of Service.

2. On April 30, 2021, PSO filed its Application Package together with accompanying workpapers along with an Application to initiate a proceeding to review PSO’s rates, charges, regulations and conditions of service and for the establishment of fair and reasonable rates and charges. PSO alleged that it complied with the Commission’s Minimum Standard Filing Requirements found at OAC 165:70-1-1 *et seq.*, by submission of its Application package.

3. PUD has reviewed the Application and Application Package and has determined that PSO’s filing is in substantial compliance with the minimum filing requirements set forth in OAC 165:70 for Class A or B utilities.

WHEREFORE, through this filing PUD hereby notifies PSO of the acceptance of the Application Package and provides notice that PSO is in substantial compliance with the minimal filing requirements for the above-styled cause as set forth in OAC 165:70 for Class A or B utilities.
