**FINAL CITATION ORDER**


This Cause came on for hearing before Curtis Johnson, Administrative Law Judge, on the Pollution and Enforcement Docket on July 9, 2013, Kerr State Office Building, Tulsa, Oklahoma, for the purpose of taking testimony and reporting to the Commission.


Commission Field Inspector/Supervisor, Bob Scott, alleges that the Respondent failed to obtain a permit for disposal into the Mainard #7 well in Section 6, Township 24 North, Range 17 East, Rogers County, Oklahoma in violation of OCC-OAC 165:10-5-2. Operator has now obtained a permit and the well is in compliance. Respondent has paid the \$1,000.00 fine of the \$5,000.00 and has agreed to pay the balance at the rate of \$1,000.00 per month until it is paid.

IT IS THEREFORE THE ORDER of the Commission that Lucre Oil Company is fined the sum of \$5,000.00 for violation of OAC 165:10-5-2. No further action is required, and this cause is closed.
