**ORDER GRANTING MOTION TO REOPEN**

The Motion to Set Aside Order No. 620379 came on for hearing before David Leavitt, Administrative Law Judge, Oklahoma Corporation Commission, on the 28th day of January, 2014, in the Commission Courtroom, Jim Thorpe Building, Oklahoma City, Oklahoma, for purposes of hearing, taking testimony and reporting to the Commission.

Charles L. Helm, Attorney, appeared for the Applicant, Slawson Exploration Company, Inc.; and Robert Miller, Attorney, appeared for Tetra Energy, LLC.

The Motion to Reopen came on for hearing and Applicant seeks to reopen the record to allow testimony and evidence regarding the proper fair market value in lieu of participation. The Administrative Law Judge recommended the Motion be granted and the Commission adopts the ALJ's decision.

**FINDINGS**

1. Pooling Order No. 620379 issued on January 15th, 2014. Applicant received and reviewed the Order and discovered that the fair market value options in lieu of participation were not consistent with values intended for the captioned unit.
2. Applicant seeks to reopen the record to provide testimony and evidence regarding the proper fair market value in lieu of participation.
